UPDATE ROOF AT ST. MICHAEL'S CHURCH

As I have mentioned the past few weeks, the roof at St. Michael's need to be replaced. I have spoken to the diocese and the roofing company and this work will take place the week of April 15th, which is school vacation week, so that the roofers can work without interruption and the students are not distracted by the noise. All daily Masses will be at St. Joseph's that week and the Adoration Chapel will be closed. This project will cost \$70,000 to complete. I am asking parishioners to kindly make a donation to help us with the cost of this necessary project. We have all seen other churches close because of disrepair, and we want to ensure that our church building be well maintained to avoid even the consideration of such a decision. To date, we have received \$8,700 in donations. Please put any donation in a regular envelope entitled "roof repairs" and put in the collection basket, drop off at the rectory or give it directly to me. Thank you again for your generous support of our parish.
