

This doesn't mean we can't come early to church, take the bulletin or the Anchor as we enter and, after we kneel and pray for a while, have a nice read. But once Mass begins, every eye and mind and heart should be with the sacred action of the liturgy. We gain so much more from the eternal truths of the Mass than could ever get from the parish bulletin or the diocesan newspaper.


