CATECHESIS ON HOLY MASS

Please, let us not leave Mass early unless it is absolutely necessary: that is, it is a true emergency. Whether we sing or not, we should stay right through to the end of the recessional hymn, if there is one. While there are possible exceptions to this guideline, most who leave early don't really need to and ought not to, plain and simple. The worst case, I believe, is those who habitually leave Mass right after receiving Holy Communion, without even stopping in the pew to make a prayer of thanksgiving. This is disrespectful to God and distracting to those who are praying and thanking God for his great gift, the Holy Eucharist. Many of us have heard it said that at the Last Supper, the only one to leave early was Judas Iscariot. Don't be a modern day Judas!
